Re: Many Island Pipe Lines (Canada) Limited (MIPL) Pierceland Supply Variance Application for the Cold Lake – Beacon Hill Decommissioning Project

Many Island Pipe Lines (Canada) Limited (MIPL), a federally regulated and wholly owned subsidiary of SaskEnergy Incorporated, a Saskatchewan Crown Corporation, is seeking comment with respect to our proposed Pierceland Supply Variance Application (the "Project").

Many Islands Pipe Lines (Canada) Limited ("MIPL") will soon be applying to the Commission of the Canada Energy Regulator (the "Commission") pursuant to Section 69 of the *Canadian Energy Regulator Act* to vary Order XG-017-2020, as amended, (the "Order") approving the Pierceland Supply Project.

The purpose of the variance is to address approximately 30 metres of MIPL pipeline within the CLBH #1 facility yard site located at SW-12-62-01-W4M, Municipal District of Bonnyville No. 87, Alberta (the Pipeline Segment). This Pipeline Segment predates the Pierceland Supply construction, is not required for the operation of the final installation, and its removal will not impact service under any circumstance. No outage is required to perform the work.

MIPL will be seeking approval for decommissioning of the Pipeline Segment. The NPS 10 pipe begins at a riser and is buried underground up until the fence line just before the metering station.

Subject to any feedback received, the Project Variance Application is anticipated to be submitted to the Commission at the end of September 2023.

As part of our commitment to ensure organizational preparedness and resilience, and to meet regulatory requirements of the Canada Energy Regulator (CER), we are seeking feedback. If you wish to have information considered in our variance application, or require more details, let us know by email as soon as possible.
