Many Islands Pipe Lines (Canada) Limited Full-Scale Emergency Response Exercise

OVERVIEW

Many Islands Pipe Lines (Canada) Limited (MIPL), SaskEnergy's federally regulated subsidiary, is planning a one-day full-scale emergency response exercise on its natural gas line system on September 29, 2021. The exercise is necessary to maintain MIPL's readiness for real-time emergency response.

A full-scale exercise is defined as a multi-agency, multi-jurisdictional activity involving actual deployment of resources in a coordinated response, as if a real emergency had occurred. It includes the mobilization of units, personnel, and equipment. During this type of exercise, participants assess plans and procedures, and evaluate coordinated responses.

EXERCISE INFORMATION

The proposed field site for MIPL's full-scale exercise is a block valve located on MIPL owned land adjacent to agricultural land in NW 2-39-26 W3M. The block valve is located on MIPL's Macklin-Unity natural gas line approximately 12 kilometres north of the Village of Denzil, SK. The proposed On-Site Command Post is located at NW-11-39-26-W3M (See the enclosed map). There will be minimal impact to area residents during the full-scale emergency response exercise. Local residents and nearby drivers may see an increased presence of MIPL personnel and equipment.

This exercise allows us to collaborate with local first responders, local and provincial governments, federal regulators and Indigenous communities. MIPL has worked with these groups throughout the exercise planning phase which started in May 2021.

SAFETY

MIPL is committed to upholding the applicable standards of environmental protection, security management, safety for its employees and the public, and engagement on emergency response and traditional land use impacts.

MIPL is federally regulated under the Canada Energy Regulator (CER). This full-scale exercise will be planned and conducted in accordance with the CER's *Onshore Pipeline Regulations* (OPR) and the Canadian Standards Association (CSA) standards.
